He cares even if we're fighting against Him. It doesn't matter whether it's physical or mental; Jesus wants to take the hurting away...to restore us to a new wholeness and health in every part of our being.
- EASTER MEANS...GOD CARES ABOUT PEOPLE WHO ARE ALONE. He cares about our inner needs as well as the outward ones, about the feelings of isolation, of not belonging and loneliness we all experience at times. And He provides for them. Besides the comfort of earthly family and friends, He also gives us the encouragement of His Holy Word in Scripture.
- EASTER MEANS...GOD HEALS BROKEN HEARTS! Mary Magdalene was one of Jesus' most devoted disciples. She was one of the women who supported Jesus and His disciples throughout His ministry. She was the first one to see the empty tomb and the last to linger in the garden, crying and brokenhearted. Perhaps that was why Jesus appeared to her first before appearing to the rest of the disciples...because she needed special comfort and reassurance.
