"In him we live and move and have our being" Acts 17:28

or

"My home is in You" And God says back to me "Loretta, My home is in you."

God knows your every move, and in fact, he knows the number of your days. So, let Acts 17:28 echo within you, always reminding you to make decisions and choices that reflect you as a light and salt to those you encounter each day.
