Faithfulness, one of the fruits of the Holy Spirit, is the concept of **unfailingly** remaining loyal to **someone** or **something** and putting that loyalty into consistent practice regardless of circumstances. It is being full of **faith** in the sense of steady devotion to a **person**, **animal**, **thing**, or **conce**pt.



One of the attributes of God is His **faithfulness**. When we say God is **faithful**, it means He is **totally trustworthy**. We can **always** count on Him. Know anyone else like this? How could we ever think that the **God** who made us, would **not** have our **best interests** at heart **all** the time?

The most important aspect of being faithful to God is to have faith in the fact that, "We know that for those who love God, all things work together for good." (Romans 8:16)

And, what about you? In what ways are you **faithful** to **God**? It is one thing to simply **believe** in Him, but another to be **faithful** to Him. When we are **truly** faithful to God, this **shapes** the way we **live**, and enables us to be **loyal** to those He has placed in our life. Being faithful to God also means **not** just **reading** the Word and **living** by it, but it also means **implementing** the teachings of His word in our daily life and **praying**.

So, in what ways are you faithful to **others**? Are you there for them when they really **need** you, when they are **depressed**, having a bad day, **consistently**, no matter what is going on in their life or yours?

And, **who** are your faithful **friends**? **How** have they been there for you in the past? Do you have any **prayer friends** who are **always** praying for you? When was the last time you thanked them?

Comforting thought: God is faithful even when we are not and when life isn't fair. When we want to throw in the towel or are feeling overwhelmed, be assured that God will provide, uplift, comfort, strengthen, and support us. Our immediate circumstances may not change but we need to be confident that God will provide us with all that we need to persevere. Let us be grateful that God is faithful even when we aren't!
